Supervision in Practice

- ▶ Identify gaps between theory and practice
- ▶ Clinical or the supervision

Influencing factors Supervision in Practice

Negatives

- ▶ Engagement from both supervisor and supervisee
- ▶ Engagement from the practice
- ▶ Historically supervise only within your discipline

Opportunities

- ▶ Whole practice engagement
- ▶ Build robust relationship between supervisor and supervisee

Practicalities

- ▶ 1 hour a week
 - ▶ Not productivity loss but investment
- ▶ Understand what needs developing - which of the four pillars
- ▶ Embed case based discussion
- ▶ Utilise direct observation
