Nurses	£3.27 per hour + MFF	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All learners will come into the practice with a Practice Assessment Document (PAD) which will outline what knowledge, skills, and proficiencies they need to achieve Each learner has the responsibility to ensure they are achieving all their learning outcomes, proficiencies, and competencies All learners must be provided with a local induction which includes providing access to all local policies and procedures It is the responsibility of the practice to ensure all learners have a designated clinical assessor/supervisor/educator to oversee the development and achievement of competencies/proficiencies in each placement Placement durations vary for each course, long-spoke placements must be arranged by L&SC PCTH Placements Project Manager, and short-spoke placements can be arranged by the learner and practice The Placement Charter is to be adhered to by both learner and educator
