We host a Virtual Forum for PCN Lead Nurses/Representatives, once a month (day and time changes monthly to allow accessibility to all).

The Forum provides useful resources, regular update of communications from local Integrated Care Board such as Infection Control and Safeguarding and National Steer. It allows nurses to share best practice and innovation across the system, collectively raise any nurse issues and provides peer support.

Each PCN will receive £45 an hour for 2 hours a month for a designated nurse to attend and be part of the collaborative. Please note this must have approval from the Practice Manager and PCN Manager.
